




Federal disability policy in Canada (3rd ed.)

In support of the federal government's initiative to consult with Canadians about new federal disability legislation, the Canadian Disability Policy Alliance (CDPA), in collaboration with the [Canadian Access and Inclusion Project \(CAIP\)](#), has prepared the 3rd edition of our disability policy scan. At this stage, only the federal portion of the document is ready for release, but we continue to work on the 13 provincial and territorial jurisdictions, and expect to release the full 3rd edition by Summer 2017. The 3rd edition has methodological updates, as well as live links to the statutes that explicitly deal with disability.
